### First Responary for the Council [of Trent]

Take away from them, O Lord, all pride, presumption and knowledge of the flesh, contentions and envies, dissensions and resentments; grant them the protection of Thy salvation that *as one and with one mouth we may honour Thee, God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.*
